2009 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION (LRB-3861/1)

HOW ARE THE PEOPLE OF WISCONSIN RESPONDING?

- Wisconsin is joining 26 other states in proposing an amendment (LRB-3861/1) to our state constitution in order to preserve our right to choice in private healthcare, allowing the state of Wisconsin to “opt out” of government healthcare.
- The 10th amendment reserves those rights that are not granted to the federal government to the states. If our United States Constitution does not list it, the federal government **CANNOT** do it!
- **IMPORTANT:** This is **NOT** the same “opt out” version that was addressed in Washington. The difference is that the Wisconsin amendment would eliminate the requirement for Wisconsinites to pay for the government plan.

- In the next legislature session beginning January 19, 2010, Joint Resolutions will be introduced in the Wisconsin Assembly and Senate.
