Below is the status of the WI Tea Party movement legislative agenda.

### Accomplished!

- ACT 1 – Repeal of Tax on Health Savings Accounts
- ACT 23 – Photo ID required to vote
- ACT 35 – Concealed Carry
- Repeal of 1% set-aside for artworks in public construction projects
- Repeal of auto insurance premium hike
- Repeal of most of combined reporting

### Still in process and need help finishing:

- SB115/AB162 – Change the date of the primaries
- SB 83 – Eminent Domain Reform
- SR 18/AJR 42 – Sovereignty Resolution
- AB 69/SB 79 – Castle Doctrine
- AB 26 - Repeal of Mascot Names Law

### Introduced but no movement yet and help is needed to move these bills to a hearing:

- AB 67 – Late Voter Registration/Absentee Balloting Reform
- SJR 21/AJR 28 – Health Care Freedom Amendment
